The following proceedings were had:

1. Curtis Fenley requested that the Council amend its policy of only paving streets which were 60 per cent settled. This matter was passed for further consideration.

2. R. C. Deal requested the Council to make some arrangements to furnish sewer to two new houses he is now finishing for two of his brothers. Passed for further consideration.

3. R. C. Musslewhite, for Mrs. G. H. Atkinson, requested the Council to correct the drainage situation on South First Street which drains through her property. Passed for further consideration.

4. Carroll Allen requested the Council to finish sewer line on his property and extending North to S. B. Line of Sherwood Street and to re-imburse his \$139.75 difference between 4 and 6 inch line. Motion carried to him \$139.75.

5. Joe DeStephano requested the Council to put a Street through his 7 acre tract of land in North Lufkin. Passed for further consideration.

6. Motion by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Joe Stegall to declare an emergency and pass a Garbage Collection Ordinance First reading. All present voted "Yea". Motion by Lee B. Zeagler and seconded by D. M. Thrash to pass Garbage Collection Ordinance on second and final reading. All present voted "Yea".

7. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Joe Stegall to pass resolution and to declare an emergency to borrow \$108,600.00 from the Lufkin National Bank, payable \$2,400.00 monthly with 4 percent interest. All present voted "Yea".

8. Motion made Lee B. Zeagler and seconded by Joe Stegall to pass resolution to borrow \$108,600.00 from Lufkin National Bank on second and final reading. All present voted "Yea".

9. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Joe Stegall to replace Parking Meters on Cotton Square, also the East side of Second Street from Lufkin Avenue to Dozier Avenue; esplanade side of Lufkin Avenue from Second to Third Streets. All present voted "Yes".

10. Motion made by Joe Stegall and seconded by D. M. Thrash to accept the City Budget tentatively, and to authorize the City Manager to have same published, as provided by law and that June 7th be set for a hearing of said Budget by the City Council in the City Hall. All present voted "Yes".

11. Motion made by Joe Stegall and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to pass resolution to ammend the Gas Ordinance of the City of Lufkin on first reading. All present voted "Yea".

12. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to pass resolution to amend the Gas Ordinance of the City of Lufkin on second and final reading. All present voted "Yes".

13. Motion made by Joe Stegall and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to refund Veterans of Foreign Wars \$20.00 electrical fees. All present voted "Yes."

14. Motion made by Joe Stegall and seconded by D. M. Thrash to cut off all water connections where water bills are not paid by the 25th of each month. All present voted "Yes".

15. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to authorize the City Manager to advertise for bids on a Street Sweeper. All present voted "Yes".

16. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to authorize the City Manager to advertise for bids on a Street Sweeper. All present voted "Yes."

17. Motion made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by Lee B. Zeagler to authorize the City Manager to purchase a Garbage Truck Body with heavy duty Anthony 7" Hydraulic Hoist. All present voted "Yes".

18. Motion made and duly seconded to pay all bills as listed. All present voted "Yes".
