After discussing the matter of appointing a City Manager, it was decided to defer action until a future date, but for the purpose of relieving City Manager C. N. Humason, on the 1st of April, 1926, on motion made by A. M. Walker, seconded by E. W. Leach, it was unanimously carried that T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, be appointed Temporary City Manager until a permanent one can be selected, and that his salary while acting in that capacity be \$250.00 per month, and that C. H. Rice, Assistant City Secretary be appointed temporarily as City Secretary.

Mr. Smitham was present and presented his application in person, giving his experiences and qualifications for the position as aforesaid.




There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried, same adjourned.
