The following proposition was made by the City Council City Messrs

That is, if Mills ~~nos 1 & 2~~ ^{no} 3 have a capacity of 300 000 gallons per day of 24 hours with no reference to Mill No. 1. The City of Lubbock to pay \$3500⁰⁰ and if Mills No. 1 and 2 have a capacity of 450 000 gallons per day of 24 hours the City to pay \$5000⁰⁰ and if Mills nos (1) one & (3) have a capacity of 650 000 gallons then the City to pay to Messrs Layne & Bowler \$5750⁰⁰ they (Layne & Bowler) ~~further agree~~ to set 120 feet additional sewer in No. 3 Mill, and to further guarantee the capacity of mills for a period of 12 months from the day they ~~are~~ are delivered to the City of Lubbock.

The above capacities of mills mentioned to be pumping capacity, accepted this 9th day of November
