MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD SEPTEMBER 13th, 1929.

Be it remembered that on this the 13th day of September, A. D.
1929, there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City
of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall in said City, with the following
officers of the City present, to-wit:- Joe C. Denman, Mayor, C. E.
Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward
No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. D. Tiner, City
Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of
Ward No. 4 was absent. The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

The purpose of the meeting as announced by the Mayor was to
consider the passage of a resolution authorizing the execution of
a substitute deed to L.H. Denman covering 10 acres of land heretofore
sold by ~~the City of Lufkin to Thomas B. Bledsoe~~ and to do and perform
any other business as may properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND
CITY SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER TO L.H. DENMAN A QUITCLAIM DEED
TO TEN ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, A PORTION OF THE A VARILLA
LEAGUE DESCRIBED IN A DEED FROM THOMAS B BLEDSOE TO A H GARBUTT DA-
TED NOVEMBER 14, 1914 AND RECORDED IN BOOK 36 PAGE 501 of the DEED
RECORDS OF ANGELINA COUNTY, TEXAS, was presented for passage and ap-
proval on first reading. C. A. Burke made a motion which was seconded
by C. E. Brazil that said ordinance be placed on its first reading,
and that it pass first reading. The motion was put by the Mayor and
all members vote "Aye" and none voted ~~no~~". Therefore it was duly
carried.

The question of raising the salary of policeman H C Billingsley
was taken up, after which it was moved by C.E. Brazil and seconded by
C A Burke that the said Billingsley's salary be raised to \$125.00
per month. The motion carried unanimously.
