TURE TOOLETS INSTALLED IN THE PLACES WHERE THE COMMODES ARE USED BY ANY PERSON OR PERSONS OTHER THAT THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY, OR ACTUAL BONA FIDE EMPLOYEES, SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH THE "U" TYPE SEATS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. C. L. Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. two made a motion that said said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on second and final reading. W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion:
