The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of meetings held during the month of December, 1937 were read,
and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MILK ORDINANCE OF
THE CITY OF LUFKIN BY PROVIDING FOR AN ANNUAL
LICENSE FEE OF TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) PER YEAR
FOR ANY AND ALL PRODUCERS AND VENDORS OF ANY KIND
OF MILK, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR,"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. W. D.
Winston, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 made a motion that said ordinance be
placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on
second and final reading. C. L. Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. 2 seconded
said motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded
vote on the motion: "AYES"- W. M. Glenn, W. D. Winston, Jr., C. L. Hicks,
and J. E. Jay. "NOES" - None - Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion car-
ried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PLUMBING ORDINANCE OF
THE CITY OF LUFKIN, BY REQUIRING THAT ALL FU*
TURE TOILETS INSTALLED IN THE PLACES WHERE THE
COMMUNES ARE USED BY ANY PERSON OR PERSONS OTHER
THAN THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY, OR ACTUAL BONA FIDE
EMPLOYEES, SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH THE "U" TYPE
SEATS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. C. L.
Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. two made a motion that said ordinance
be placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on
second and final reading. W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded the motion. The May-
or put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion:
"AYES" W. M. Glenn, W. D. Winston, Jr., C. L. Hicks, and J. E. Jay. "NOES"-
None - Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance
passed and approved on second and final reading.
