When the following proceedings were had to wit:-

Moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney that the sum of  
Twenty dollars be allowed Mayor Joe C. Denman as traveling expenses  
to and from Kerrville for the purpose of declaring the results of  
Special Election held for the purpose of electing a Commissioner  
from Ward #1. Motion carried unanimously.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND  
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE  
CITY OF LUFKIN ON THE 26th. DAY OF NOVEMBER A. D. 1930 FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF ELECTING A CITY-COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. ONE" was  
presented for passage and approval. Same having been read to the  
City Commission and by move and second duly made and carried the  
Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance finally passed  
and approved.

Whereas, an election was duly and legally held within and for the  
City of Lufkin, Texas, on the 26th. day of November A. D. 1930 for the  
purpose of electing a City Commissioner from Ward No. 1 in and for said  
City of Lufkin, Texas, under and accordance with the Charter of and for  
said city; and the returns of said election having been made to, and  
canvassed by the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, from  
which said returns it appears that at said election 74 votes were  
cast, of which number W. O. Greene received 72 votes for Commissioner  
of Ward No.1 and Sam R. Parker received 2 votes for Commissioner of  
Ward No. 1.
