4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held May 6, 2014, were approved on a motion by Councilmember Lynn Torres and seconded by Councilmember Sarah Murray. A unanimous affirmative vote was recorded to approve the minutes as presented.

5. PRESENTATION OF THE 2013 CITY OF LUFKIN COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT BY ERIC CARVER, CPA, AXLEY & RODE, LLP.
