City Manager W.D. Tiner recommended a special rate on sewer rentals to Daviscourt, a tourist camp on North First Street, such rate to be thirty (30%) cents per month per cottage, which amount is to be paid quarterly in advance as other sewer rentals, and to be continuous,

wheter occupied or not. By vote of the City commission such rate was adopted unanimously.

A request having been made for a water line to serve W.A.Behannon property on Huntington Highway, and same having been considered by the City Commission it was unanimously carried that the City would lay the line if said W.A.Behannon would furnish all material necessary for same, and the City Manager was so instructed.
