In order to allow the City Engineer time to compute the aggregate of the several bids, the Council recessed to meet at the City Hall at 7:30 P. M. to-day.

Pursuant to recess, the Honorable Council met at the City Hall at 7:30 P. M., Friday, March 5, 1915, with the following officers present:

The Council was malled to order by the Honorable Mayor.

The City Engineer submitted his report of the approximate aggregate of the several bids, which was read, as inkeres and of which the following is a synopsis! (See report in detail hereto attached and made a part of this record):

J. E. Overly & Company, supplemented their bid with the following proposal:

"We will put in 4 inch base and cement filler with asphalt expansion joint for fifteen cents per square yard less, or in other words will deduct \$2,370.00 from the total of our bid, provided it is all put in. I will also agree to put in concrete paving as per specifications, using gravel instead of granite for the sum of one dellar and eighty cents per square yard for the paving."

As the supplementary proposal is somewhat indefinite, and not provided for in specifications, I have not attempted to summarize the approximate cost.

The 4 inch base is not specified in the specifications. Several of the bidders asked me if I would receive bids with 4 inch base in specifications, to which I consented subject to the final action of your honors on this particular matter.

E. J. Overly & Company, not represented.

Mr. _____, representing the Thurber Brick Company, appeared and presented the merits of Verticle Fiber Brick as a pavement.

Mr. F. P. Hamilton, Vice President of the Cresoted Wood Block Paving Company, appeared, presenting the merits of Cresoted Wood Blocks as a pavement.

Mr. L. W. Kemp, representing The Texas Company, appeared and gave the Council an interesting talk and some valuable information bearing the on the history of different pavements in Texas.

The Hon. Mayor and Council retired in executive session to deliberate on and consider the several proposals and merits of the several pavements.

After deliberate consideration, the Council decided to reject the bid of C. M. McConnico for wood block pavements, and of J. O. Polhemus, for Verticle Fiber Brick, both being high bidders on these pavements, and the City Engineer was directed to return their respective checks deposited, which was done, and that further consideration and action be deferred until 7:30 P. M., Tuesday, March 9, 1915, whereupon, the Honorable Council adjourned until 7:30 P. M., Tuesday, March 9, 1915.
