ing business was transacted:

1. The Commission met to consider the re-location of the 12" water line and it was voted to draw in or re-locate a portion of the proposed 12" water line from its original location, and it was agreed to locate said lines as shown on Plan "C". It was agreed that the 6" and 8" lines would be installed in the Northeast section of the City of Lufkin and after that, the 6" or 8" ~~would be located in the vicinity~~ of the new school.
2. The Commission authorized C. E. Brazil, City Attorney, to negotiate with Mrs. C. F. Thompson for an elevated water tank site on her property, and to make her a specific offer for such a site.
3. Mr. Jack Nerren was authorized to negotiate with the owners of what is known as the Jones Property in the East portion of the City relative to the purchase of same by the City.
4. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
