

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPTEMBER 18,
1956, AT 7:30 P..M.

On this the 18th day of September, A. D. 1956,
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened
in regular session, in the regular meeting place in

being present, and the following absent: E. A. Gibbs, City
Secretary, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting of September 4, and of the called meeting of September 11, were read and approved.
3. Bids were opened on the sewer line improvements and the firm of Wilkes, Dake, & Steed of Tyler, Texas, being the lowest bidder in the sum of \$84,857.00 the contract was awarded to them.
4. A resolution was passed authorizing the city to borrow \$20,000.00 from the Lufkin National Bank, such sum to be used for operating expenses and to pay current bills.
5. Mrs. Rita Jenkins was recommended as temporary city secretary, and H. R. Ralston was recommended as part-time city judge, at a salary not to exceed \$150.00 per month, to act in the place of E. A. Gibbs, resigned.
6. Bills for the month of August were approved and ordered to be paid.
7. There being no further business to come before the commission the meeting adjourned.
