

## MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JULY 11th, A.D. 1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 11th day of July, A.D. 1930 there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said city with the following officers of the City present, to-wit: Joe C. Denman, Mayor, presiding, C. E. Brazil, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, R. C. Jordan, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, W. D. Tiner, City Manager, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the meeting was to pass the following ordinances: (1) An ordinance appointing the members of the Board of Equalization of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1930, and (2) An ordinance making the annual tax levy of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year A.D. 1930, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance appointing the Members of the Board of Equalization in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year A.D.1930" was presented for passage and approval on first reading. C.A. Burke made a mtion which was seconed by R.C.Jordan, that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that same pass first reading. The motion having been put by the mayor, the following vote is recorded—Ayes—Joe C.Denman, C.E.Brazil, C.A.Burke, R.C.Jordan and W.A. Abney. NoesO None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance passed on first reading.

Assessed and Collected by the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the year 1930, and for each year thereafter until otherwise provided was presented for passage and approval on first reading. C.A.Burke made a motion which was seconded by C.E.Brazil that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that same pass first reading. The motion was put by the Mayor and the following vote is here recorded: "AYES"— Joe C Denman, C E Brazil, C A Burke, R C Jordan and W A Abney.
