

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD Dec.12th,1927.

Be it remembered that on this the 12th day of December, A.D.1927,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission~~r~~ of
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof; Present
and presiding the Hon. J.W.Hawkins, Mayor, A. M. Walker, Commissioner
of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach,
Commissioner of Ward No. 4 (Joe C.Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1
being absent) V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney
and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had
to-wit:-

Pursuant to writt~~in~~ notice the City Commission met in called ses-
sion on this day for the purpose of amending or establishing and de-
fining the Fire Limits of the City of Lufkin, Texas. The written no-
tice is of record in these minutes and is hereby referred to for pur-
pose of defining the purpose of the call meeting.

After careful and deliberate consideration of the question of
the passage and approval of and ordinance relative to establishing
the fire limits of the city, on motion made by M. C. Spivey and sec-
onded by A. M. Walker, the following styled ordinance was presented
for passage and approval as an emergency measure, to-wit:-

AN ORDINANCE ESTABDISHING AND DEFINING FIRE LIMITS IN THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, PROVIDING CHARACTER OF MATERIAL TO BE USED IN ERECTING
CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING OR REMOVING OR ROOFING BUILDINGS WITHIN SAID
LIMITS; PROVIDING ~~PE~~MALTIES FOR VIOLATION WITH AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE; AND
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCE AND PARTS OF ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Mayor put the question and requested all members of the City Commission
who favored said motion and the passage of said ordinance to vote "Aye"
and those opposed to vote "no". The following members voted "Aye"- J.W.
Hawkins, M. M. Walker, M.C.Spivey and E.W.Leach- The following membe~~rs~~
voted "No"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carred and
said ordinance passed and approved on final reading as an emergency
