It is ordered that the city of Lufkin Texas lease the ground upon which the old city pond is located consisting of 3.7 acres more, or less to Dr. R. P. O'Brian for the purpose of drilling and prospecting for oil upon the terms and specifications stipulated in the said Dr. R. P. O'Brians contract as submitted to the City Council for their approval. Said contract and specifications having been approved by the Council and signed by the mayor and secretary at this meeting of the Council and \$1.00 paid by Dr. R. P. O'Brian in consideration of closing said contract legally.

It is ordered that the mayor order a car of Alum in sacks

It is ordered that the city of Lufkin Texas credit the City Depository, the Lufkin Guaranty State Bank and Trust Co. with 2 1/2 per cent dating from Jan. 1st 1918, or that said city make no charges against said Bank & Trust Co. for the money deposited with said Bank & Trust Co. under the contract with said Bank to handle the City's funds in the capacity of City Treasurer, dating from said 1st day of Jan. 1918

It is ordered that an election be held in the city of Lufkin Texas on the first Tuesday in April 1918 at the Fire Station in said city for the purpose of electing two city aldermen and the mayor is hereby authorized and required to make and publish all notices of said election as required by law.

There being no further business the Council adjourned
