Juplin Texas Jan. 2nd 1918

The City Council of the City of Juplin Texas met on the 2nd day of Jan. 1918 with the following named officers present K. Morgan, mayor presiding, S. W. Hawthorne, J. A. Behannon, W. D. Newsom, W. D. Price and W. A. Cook aldermen; R. P. Walker secretary and S. H. Townsend City attorney.

The reports of K. Morgan mayor; R. P. Walker secretary J. S. Cochran marshal; E. A. Perkins water Commissioner O. C. Stewart pound master and W. L. Sullivan Sanitary inspector were read and approved.

The proposition of S. H., G. E. + W. J. Townsend to exchange a part of lot number 6 in Block number 8 in the city of Juplin Texas for a part of the alley in said Block number 8 was discussed by members of the Council and property owners, owning property in said Block number 8 and it was decided not to make the exchange as said property owners object to having any part of said alley being closed from the public.

All current accounts owing by the city were ordered paid.

There being no further business the Council adjourned subject to the call of the mayor.
