MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
OCTOBER 3rd, 1930.

Be it remembered that on this the 3rd day of October, A. D. 1930,
there was held a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Luf-
kin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof, with the following officers

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:--

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The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to decide about
widening Bynum Street, or Old Diboal Road, to a width of 50 feet through
or adjoining property of C.H. Harrell, J.A. Ashley and Elmer Ashley, said
parties having refused to make proper dedication of street, there now
being going on a program of improvement of said street.

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After discussing thoroughly the matter as aforesaid, it was moved
by R. C. Jordan, and seconded by W. A. Abney, that the City Attorney
be authorized and directed to institute condemnation proceedings against
the said C. H. Harrell, J. A. Ashley and Elmer Ashley for the purpose of
securing necessary right-of-way to widen Bynum Street to a width of 50
feet, through or adjoining land of the said C.H. Harrell, J.A. Ashley and
Elmer Ashley. The motion carried unanimously.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, by
move and second duly made and carried, same adjourned.
