MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION HELD ON AUGUST 5th
1930.

Be it remembered that on the 5th day of August, A.D. 1930, there was held a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:-

when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

Wm. A. Foster, president of the Angelina County Fair Association appeared before the City Commission and requested that the City extend its water main on Ellis Avenue to the City limits at which point the Fair Association wished to connect for water service at the Fair Grounds. On motion made by W.A. Abney seconded by C.A. Burke it was unanimously carried that such extension be made, using a ~~2 1/2~~ inch cast iron pipe for such extension.

A deed from Long-Bell Lbr Co. conveying to the City of Lufkin a strip of land 10 feet in width thereby widening Church street at the point it intersects with Lufkin Avenue was presented for acceptance. On motion made by R.C. Jordan, seconded by C.A. Burke it was unanimously carried that such deed be accepted, and that a refund be made to the Long Bell Lbr Co covering the cost of paving 10 feet on Lufkin Avenue on the South side of same, representing the amount paid by the said Long Bell Lbr Co for paving the said 10 feet now conveyed to the City for street purposes.

Accounts and bill due by the city to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such of said bill as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid on motion duly made and carried same were allowed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion
duly made and carried, same adjourned.
