the following business was transacted:

- 1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Pro-tem, W.F. Collins.
- 2. The Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 17th were read and approved.
- 3. Curtis Swain appeared before the Commission relative to the purchase of the City Warehouse Property. He had heretofore bid \$35,000.00 on such property, and he having been the highest bidder, proposed to raise such bid to \$40,000.00. The City Commission voted unanimously to sell him such property to him provided the City would retain possession thereof until it could acquire its new location, or not longer than six (6) months.
- 4. The Lufkin Telephone Exchange Rate Ordinance was passed on second and final reading.
- 5. The Lufkin Independent School District Plat was tentatively approved with the request that Trenton Street be opened to Circle Drive.
- 6. The Commission approved payment of estimate No. 1 of Cardinal Pool, on the Jones Lake Park Swimming Pool, in the amount of \$18,629.70.
- 7. The Commission ordered publication of Zone Application of Rastus Redd, et ux, to change the Zone from "A" to "F" District on a parcel of land 100 feet by 111.3 feet between Old State Highway No. 40 and Wilson Avenue.
- 8. The proposed Privy Ordinance was discussed and the City Attorney was instructed to re-write same with certain definite and specific clauses to be inserted therein.
- 9. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
