1. The Mayor announced that the meeting was for the purpose of discussing with Mr. Nabors, District Highway Engineer, the matter of locating a proposed loop around the business district for Highway 59. Mr. York and Mr. Seale accompanied Mr. Nabors to the meeting.

2. After a full discussion of the matter, upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded by J. E. Jay, a resolution was passed to the effect that the City make every effort to secure the necessary right-of-way for a 56 foot paved highway through the City.

3. The grading and curbing of the proposed loop would be taken care of by the City, the highway department to do the paving. The highway department required that the City secure and pay for all necessary right-of-way.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
