## MINUTES OF A CALL MESTING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUPKIN, TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 9th, 1926.

He it remembered that on this the 9th day of December, A. D. 1926, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding Hon. J.W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, E.W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, (Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W.A. Behannon, being absent), V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W.O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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This was a joint meeting of the City Commission and the county Commissioners' court, and was for the purpose of receiving Cedication from the County Commissioners' Court to the City of Lufkin, Texas, certain property around the Court House square to be used for parking and street purposes, and execute contract with Reynolds & Sutton of Tyler, Texas, for the improvement of the property so dedicated, and to do and perform such other business as may properly come before the meeting.

Proper dedication of the property around the Court House square was duly dedicated by the Commissioners' Court, a copy of such order authorizing the County Judge to execute such dedication being of record in these minutes, and the dedication itself being of record in the Deed Records of Angelina County, Texas, to which reference is hereby made for description etc.

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A contract was executed with Reynolds & Sutton of Tyler, Texas, by the County Commissioners' Court and the City of Lufkin, Texas, jointly, for the paving and improving of the courthouse square. Such contract was executed in triplicate, a copy of same being filed with the Angelina County Commissioners' Court, a copy being filed with the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, and a copy being sent to said Reynolds & Sutton, at Tyler, Texas.

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A bonds duly executed by Reynolds & Sutton covering the work to be performed in connection with the improvement of the courthouse square was presented, and on motion duly made and carried was accepted. The question of borrowing sufficient funds with which to pay the city's part of the cost of improving the court house square was disbussed, after which it was moved by E.W.Leach and seconded by Joe C.

Denman that the City borrow sufficient funds with which to pay the city's entire part of the improvement of the courthouse square as aforesaid.

The motion carried unanimously.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duby made and carried, same adjourned.
