W. C. Trout, W. C. Binion and K. W. Denman, composing a committee from the Lions Club appeared before the City Commission in behalf of an appropriation for the benefit of the Lion's Club Band. They requested that an amount of \$30.00 per month be set up in the annual budget for the purpose. Final action was not taken on the matter, as the budget had not yet been prepared, but were promised a consideration of the matter at the proper time.
