TEXAS, CHIEFOF APR.
EIGHTH, 1933.

Be it remembered that on this the 21th day of April, A.D. 1933,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and
for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City
with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

C. A. Burke,	Coms. Ward No. 2,

M. M. Jones, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to canvass the returns and de-
clare the result of the regular General City Election which was held
April 4th, 1933, for the purpose of electing a City Mayor and a City
Commissioner from each of Wards Nos one and Three, and to transact
any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN APRIL, A.D. 1933. SAME BEING
THE 4th DAY OF APRIL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR, A CITY
COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO. 1, and A CITY COMMISSIONER FROM WARD NO.

"THREE" was presented for passage and approval, Said Ordinance having
been read to the City Commission, it was moved by C. A. Burke and
seconded by W. A. Abney that said ordinance be passed and approved.

The motion having been put by the Mayor, the following is the vote on
same: "Ayes", Wm. A Foster, W.O.Greene, C.A. Burke and W.A.Abney.

"Noes"- None. Whereupon the ordinance was declared to have been unani-
mously adopted. (See another page of these minutes for a record of
said ordinance).

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W. C. Trout, W. C. Binion and K. W. Denman, composing a com-
mittee from the Lions Club appeared before the City Commission in
behalf of an appropriation for the benefit of the Lion's Club Band.
They requested that an amount of \$30.00 per month be set up in the
annual budget for the purpose. Final action was not taken on the
matter, as the budget had not yet been prepared, but were promised a
consideration of the matter at the proper time.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
