They suggested to Mr. Early that he have an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance drawn permitting building on the R.O.W. line with the exception of filing stations.
- 4. Coy Mattox and Fred Wilson requested, by letter, that Taxi Cab Permit No. 91 be transferred from Coy Mattox to Fred M. Wilson. Request granted.
- 5 Commission authorized City Manager to pay members of Equalization Board, the same rate per day, that the School District pays.
- L. City Manager presented a petition submitted by Mr. Weeks requesting the paving of one block of Jodie Ave., between South Third St. and Charleton, at no cost to the property owners. Request rejected.
