The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to pass a resolution authorizing and empowering the Mayor and City Secretary to execute an agreement to maintain from year to year Denman Avenue (Extended) from South First Street to Raguet Street if same is improved by Texas Highway Department, and a like agreement to Maintain from year to year First Street from North City Limits to South City Limits if same is improved by Texas Highway Department.

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A Resolution entitled "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN AUTHORIZING MAYOR AND SECRETARY OF CITY OF LUFKIN TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT TO MAINTAIN FROM YEAR TO YEAR FIRST STREET FROM NORTH CITY LIMITS TO SOUTH CITY LIMITS WITHIN CITY OF LUFKIN IF SAME IS IMPROVED BY TEXAS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT" was presented for passage and approval. Said resolution having been read to the City Commission, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W. A. Abney that said resolution be passed and approved. The Mayor put the question, and the following is the recorded vote on same. "AYES"-- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene and W. A. Abney. "NOES"-- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and approved.

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A resolution entitled "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN AUTHORIZING MAYOR AND SECRETARY OF CITY OF LUFKIN TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT TO MAINTAIN FROM YEAR TO YEAR DENMAN AVENUE (EXTENDED) FROM SOUTH FIRST STREET TO RAGUET STREET WITHIN CITY OF LUFKIN IF SAME IS IMPROVED BY TEXAS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT" was presented

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for passage and approval. Said resolution having been read to the City Commission, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W.A. Abney, that said resolution be passed and approved. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on same. "AYES"- W.A. Foster, W. O. Greene, and W. A. Abney. "NOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and approved.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
