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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JAN. 27th.
1926.

Be it remembered that on this the 27th. day of January, A.D. 1926, there was begun and holden a called meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City; Present and presiding, J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commission of Ward No. 1, A. M. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the matter of further extensions of the water mains of the city; the question of employing another paid fireman, making three all together, and the matter of a bond issue for the purpose of building a new fire station.

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City Manager was instructed to proceed with the construction of water lines as follows:- 1,000 feet of 2 inch water line on Jack St; 1,250 feet of 4 inch on Leach Avenue; 1,000 feet of 4 inch on Everitt St; 550 feet of 4 inch on Menefee St; 1500 feet of 4 inch on South Raguet St; 500 feet of 4 inch on Jefferson Ave; 800 feet of 4 inch on South 3rd St; 320 feet of 6 inch on 4th Street; 3000 feet of 2 inch on Lufkin Land Street toward Lufkin Land School House or Second Baptist Church; 2000 feet of 2 inch on old Burke Road; 800 feet of 2 inch on Jay Street. Also 10 fire Hydrants; 15 valves and sufficient lead and Oakum.

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Discussion of the question of putting on a third paid fireman was discussed, after which on motion made by E.W. Leach and seconded by W.A. Behannon, the City Manager was instructed to employ a third man. Said City Manager reported that Oran Hubbard and Holly Gibson had heretofore been employed and stated that he would employ Lanier Russell as the third man.

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Action on the matter of a Bond Issue for the purpose of building a new fire station was deferred to some future date.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on

motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
