Juplin Texas Jan 29th 1918

The City Council of the City of Juplin Texas met on this the 29th day of Jan. 1918 in adjourned session with the following officers present K. Morgan mayor presiding W. D. Price, S. W. Hawthorne, W. A. Coole, W. D. Newsom and J. A. Behannon aldermen; W. D. Price acting as secretary pro Tempore when the proposition of Dr. R. P. O'Brien to lease the ground, surrounding and upon which the old City pond is located for a period of five years more, or less was discussed and referred to the water Committee for their consideration.

Moved and seconded and all Aldermen voting yea that the city rent, from Mrs. N. B. Chaney, the building on the North East corner of Cotton Square and Juplin Avenue at \$15.00 per month for a water Commissioners office and E. A. Perkins, water Commissioner is ordered to arrange said building for occupancy at once.

The salaries of all City officers of the City of Juplin Texas were fixed by order of the City Council as follows;

Mayor \$5.00 for each Council meeting and a salary of \$12.50 per month.

Aldermen per diem for each Council meeting and a salary of \$8.33 1/3 per month.

The City Marshal a salary of \$75.00 per month
Deputy City Marshal \$25.00 per month all
aldermen voting yea.

It is ordered by the Council that the Mayor contract for oil required by the City for the year 1918.

Moved and seconded and so ordered that the Council adjourn.
