The application had been previously approved by the zoning board and upon motion of B. F. Milligan and second by D. M. Thrash was approved for advertisement for public hearing.
2. February bills in the amount of \$13,466.37 were reviewed and upon motion of E. A. Gibbs and second by B. F. Milligan were ordered paid.
3. A general discussion of city affairs was held with no official action taken.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
