

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD AUGUST 24th.
1923.

Be it remembered that on this the 24th day of August, A. D. 1923. there was begun and holden a call meeting of of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof; present and presiding the Hon. Sam H Kerr, Mayor, C. F. Becker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1. J. W. Lewis, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, towit:*

An Ordinance entitled an "Ordinance accepting the proposal of R. B. Shearer of Lufkin, Texas, for the construction of a Pump Station Building at the City's Pumping plant", was duly presented for passage and approval and after due consideration of same, it was moved by Commissioner C. F. Becker and seconded by Commissioner J. W. Lewis, that the said proposal of R. B. Shearer be accepted and that said ordinance be passed and approved on first reading, and that said ordinance be passed as an emergency measure. The Mayor put the question and instructed all those members who favored the passage of said ordinance to vote "Aye" and those who opposed the passage of said ordinance to vote "No". The following members of the City Commission voted "Aye" S.H.Kerr, C.F.Becker, J.W.Lewis, W.A.Behannon and W. B. Treadwell. The following members voted "No"- None. The Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance finally passed and approved on first and second reading as an emergency measure.
