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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE

On this day the City Commission met in called session at the City Hall in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding: J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. A. Abney, Commissioer of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the meeting was to accept certain streets as being completed by the contractor, and to do and perform such other business as might properly come before the meeting.

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On motion made by C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, all voting yea, North Bonner Street from its interesection with north line of Frank Avenue to its interesection with south line of West Persimmon Avenue, and Dozier Avenue from its intersection with West line of Fourth Street to its interesection with west line of third Street, were received and accepted by the City as being complete in accordance with the paving contract providing for the paving of said streets.

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The City Commission discussed at length the matter as to what streets would be paved under the new paving program provided for by the recent \$100,000.00 bond issue. An agreement w~~as~~ finally reached and a~~r~~ statement ordered prepared for publication and notice as provided by law.

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The matter of paving Sayesstreet was discussed and it appearing that the property owners would not come in for their part of the cost of same at this time, but by agreement it was ordered that the sum of \$4,000.00 be withheld to appropriate for such paving provided the property owners co-operate in the program.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.

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MINUTES OF CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN HELD MARCH 6, 1929.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of March A. D. 1929, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Hall thereof with the following members present, to-wit: Dr. J. W. Hawkins, Mayor, J. C. Denman, Commissioner Ward No.1; C. A. Burke, Commissioner Ward No.2; M. C. Spivey Commissioner Ward No.3; W. A. Abney, Commissioner Ward No.4; V. R. Smitham, City Manager, and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary and W. O. Seale, City Attorney, when the following proceedings were heard, to-wit:

It appearing to the City Commission that that portion of two streets or avenues, viz:

- (a) North Bonner Street from its intersection with north line of Frank Avenue to its intersection with south line of West Persimmon Avenue;
- (b) Dozier Avenue from its intersection with west line of Fourth Street to its intersection with west line of Third Street;

have been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date Aug. 24th A. D. 1928, and the acceptance of said avenues or streets has been recommended in writing by City Engineer and City Manager, Mr. V. R. Smitham; on motion C. A. Burke, seconded by W. A. Abney, all voting yea, said streets or avenues were accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said streets or avenues are now received and accepted by the City.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessments ordinance heretofore passed, a form of said assessment certificate has heretofore been approved for use in the present paving program, which is in all respects approved.
