Two bids were received from the foolowing named peresons and in the amounts shown:-

R. B. Shearer---	\$7,400.00
C. W. Severance, Hb.	7,448.35

After due consideration and careful deliberation of the above bids, it was moved by B. L. Zeagler, and seconded by S. R. Parker, that the bid of R. B. Shearer be accepted and the contract for the construction of said Municipal Building be awarded to the said R.B. Shearer according to the plans and specifications heretofore accepted with amendments. Said motion carried unanimously.
