and E. A. Gibbs, constituting a quorum when the following  
business was transacted:

1. The meeting was called by the Mayor for the purpose of discussing the water shortage in the City. After discussing the situation the Commission passed an ordinance prohibiting the watering of yards, lawns, etc., between the hours of 6:00 A. M. and 8:00 P. M. of each day and allowing the watering of yards, lawns, and gardens, etc., on the odd days of the month from 8:00 P. M. to 6:00 A. M. where the houses have odd numbers; and on the even days of the month between the hours 8:00 P. M. and 6:00 A. M., where the houses have even numbers, and no watering at all shall be permitted at any time of the day on the last day of each month having 31 days.

2. There being no further business to come before the Commission the meeting adjourned.
