LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD FEB.
3rd, 1934.

Be it remembered that on this the 3rd day of February, A. D. 1934,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNED BY MRS. VIRGIE SCHULLER AND OTHERS? AS HEIRS OF J. D. MOFFETT AND WIFE, WHICH IS A PART OF THE H. D. MOFFETT OLD HOMESTEAD AND A PORTION OF THE JOHN L. QUINALTY LEAGUE IN ANGELINA COUNTY, TEXAS, BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO BE NECESSARY FOR STREET PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO PURCHASE FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN SUCH PROPERTY BY AGREEMENT FROM THE OWNERS THEREOF AND PAY FROM THE FUNDS BELONGING TO SAID CITY AND AVAILABLE THEREFOR THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR SUCH PROPERTY", was introduced for passage and ap-

proval on second reading, after which it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by D. A. Campbell that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that it be passed and approved on second reading. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on said motion: "AYES"-- Wm. A. Foster, C. A. Burke, D. A. Campbell. "NOES"-- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion unanimously adopted and the said ordinance passed and approved on second reading.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNED BY D. H. ADAMS AND WIFE, EMMIE ADAMS, WHICH IS A PART OF LOT TWO IN BLOCK THREE OF THE DENMAN ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF LUFKIN BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO BE NECESSARY FOR STREET PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO PURCHASE FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN SUCH PROPERTY BY AGREEMENT FROM THE OWNERS THEREOF AND PAY FROM FUNDS BELONGING TO SAID CITY AND AVAILABLE THEREFOR THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR


SUCH PROPERTY AND MOVE IMPROVEMENTS THEREFROM AT THE EXPENSE OF SAID CITY", was introduced for passage and approval on second reading, after which it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by D. A. Campbell that said ordinance be placed on second reading and that it be passed and approved on second reading. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on said motion: "AYES"- Wm. A. Foster, C. A. Burke and D. A. Campbell. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion unanimously carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second reading.
