constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin, a resolution was introduced and passed accepting the paving on certain streets. This resolution will be found following these minutes. All Commissioners present voted "Yea".

2. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by J. E. Jay, an ordinance levying taxes and fixing the tax rate was introduced and passed on final reading. This ordinance and the proceedings had thereon will be found following these minutes.

3. Upon motion of J. E. Jay, seconded by Cary C. Trevathan, an ordinance authorizing Paving Unit No. 2 was introduced upon first reading. This ordinance and the proceedings had thereon will be found following these minutes.

4. Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by J. E. Jay, all commissioners present voting "Yea", W. F. Jones and Roy Roberts were granted one taxi permit each.

5. The resignations of Ernest P. Medford and R. R. Ellison as members of the Zoning Board were accepted.

6. The bills for the month of September were approved and ordered paid.

7. The minutes of all meetings held during the month of September were read, approved and adopted.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
