An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6 and 11 of AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED ON SECOND RND FINAL READING ON THE L6th DAY OF JANUARY, 1934, AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A DEED OF TRUST ON CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO THE LUFKIN NATIONAL BANK AND THE FIRST STATE BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND PROVIDING THAT THE PROCEEDS OF A SPECIAL FUND BE DIVIDED EQUALLY BETWEEN SAID BANKS UNTIL THE NOTES EXECUTED BY SAID CITY IN FAVOR OF EACH OF SAID BANKS

ARE FULLY PAID", was introduced for passage and approval on first reading, after which it was moved by C. A. Burke and seconded by D. A. Campbell that—said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. The question was put by the Mayor and the following is the recorded vote on said motion: "AYES"— Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke, D. A. Campbell and W. A. Abney. "NOES"— None— Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion unanimously carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
