

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 2,
1941 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 2nd day of December, A. D. 1941, the
City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in regular
session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the follow-
ing members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: Commissioner W. A. Green,
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of all meetings held during the month of Nov-
ember were read and approved.

2. A number of dairymen in Angelina County appeared in re-
gard to securing protection from outside competition. The matter
was discussed but no action was taken.

3. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin,
with all commissioners present voting "Aye", the plat of the South-
land Addition to the City of Lufkin was approved.

4. Gill DeWitt appeared before the Council and requested sewer
and water services for the Southland Addition. The Council agreed
to construct a 6 inch sewer main and a 6 inch water main to Herty St.
provided \$3,000 be advanced to pay part of the costs, \$2,000 to be
returned upon completion and connecting up of ten houses and \$100
per house to be returned for each of the next ten houses completed
and connected.

There being no further business to come before the meeting,
it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
