- / The minutes of all meetings held during the month of November were read and approved.
- 2. A number of dairymen in Angelina County appeared in regard to securing protection from outside competition. The matters was discussed but no action was taken.
- 3. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin, with all commissioners present voting "Aye", the plat of the Southland Addition to the City of Lufkin was approved.
- 4. Gill DeWitt appeared before the Council and requested sewer and water services for the Southland Addition. The Council agreed to construct a 6 inch sewer main and a 6 inch water main to Herty St. provided \$3,000 be advanced to pay part of the costs, \$2,000 to be returned upon completion and connecting up of ten houses and \$100 per house to be returned for each of the next ten houses completed and connected.
