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SUBJECT: Minutes of City Council Oct. 25th. 1915.

Be it known that pursuant to the adjournment of the City Council at their adjourned session on Oct. 6th. 1915 there came on and was held a nother adjourned session of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas in their chamber Halls on this the 25th. day of October 25th. A.D. 1915 at 8 P.M. O'clock.

The following officers were present.

The following business was had to wit:

Mr. M. A. Westcott of Houston, Texas re-presenting the Houston East And West Texas Railway Company apperated before the Council and requested that his Company should be required to pay only two thirds of the cost of paving on their right of way at Ellis Avenue and Dozier Avenue where up on it was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Behanon that ~~the~~ one-third of the cost for pavement on the right of H.E. & W.T. Ry. Co. at Ellis Avenue and Dozier Avenue be paid by the City, and that an ordinance be prepared and introduced providing there-for, all aldermen voting "AYE".

The Honorable John F. Robinson with his attorney K. W. Dennaan apperated before the Council requesting that a nuisance maintained by Dr. W. C. Fuller in Largent addition be abated. Where-up-on Alderman Price moved and Alderman Behanon seconded it that the City Attorney and the City Health Officer be and they are each here-by ordered and directed to serve a legal notice on the said Dr. W. C. Fuller to abate said nuisance and to take the necessary steps to inforce compliance with said notice. All Aldermen voted "AYE".

Moved By Alderman Price and Seconded by Alderman Hawthorne that the bond of Charles Ellis as night Marshall be returned for correction. All Alderman voting "AYE".

City engineer McCarthy submitted a final estimate and certificate of the construction of the re-inforced wasteway and parapet walls at City Reservoir No. 22, under a contract entered into between the City and John Hablin, dated August 24th. 1915. certifying that the total cost thereof according the said contract amounting to \$ 3,066.29 Where-up-on it was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Behanon that ordinance No. 98 providing for the acceptance and approval of said estimate and the acceptance and approval of said work as executed and authorizing and directing the Mayor and City Secretary to issue to said John Hablin or his order upon treasury warrants of the City of Lufkin, Texas, amounting in the aggregate \$3,066.29 in full payment there-of upon the said John Hablin executing and delivering to the Mayor sufficient and satisfactory evidence of the payment of all bills and claims for labor and material. All Aldermen voting "AYE".

In pursuance of notice duly given by the City Engineer, the following bid was opened by the City Council for paving laying concrete sidewalk under provisions of ordinance No. 95:

Lufkin Concrete Company at 12 1/2 cents per square foot for concrete sidewalk, forty cents per lineal foot for concrete steps and forty cents per lineal foot for concrete curb. Said bid was accompanied by certified check drwan on the Guaranty State Bank and Trust Company for \$ 150.00. It was agreed that action there-on be de-ferred until the regular meeting of the City Council.

Moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Hawthorne that the City Engineer be and he is here-by ordered abd directed to invite bids by notice with-out publication to be received up to 8 O'clock P.M. Tuesday Oct. 2nd. 1915 for laying 1,233 feet of eight inch water main near water reservoir No. 1 according to specifications schedule No. 1 for 5,335 feet more or less of 6 inch water main along Bayou Avenue and First Street to connect with the 8 inch main on Davis Avenue and the 6 inch main at First street and Bremond Avenue and approximately 400 feet

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of 4 inch main on Bonner Street between Oak Avenue and point at or near Compress on or near Abney Avenue. All Alderman voting AYE.

Alderman Price moved and Alderman Behan seconded that the City Attorney be and he is hereby ordered and directed to prepare and submit at the next regular meeting of the Council a penalty ordinance making it a mis-demeanor for any person to tap any water main or make any connection with the water main or to turn on water at any connection with-out first securing a permit and otherwise making satisfactory arrangements with the Water Commissioner for that purpose and making it a violation subjective of fine of not less than \$10 .00 dollars nor more than \$25.00 for any person thus offending. All Alderman voting Aye.

There being no further business. the council adjourned.
