

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 1945 AT 3:00 P. M.

On this, the 8th, day of November, 1945, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following memebers thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: Jas. A. Abney, Commissioner Ward 4, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

(.Upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by E. A. Gibbs, October bills, in the amount of \$4,191.16 were approved and ordered paid by unanimous vote. Motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by E. A. Gibbs and carried by unanimous vote, to pass an ordinance on second reading changing the fire limits of the City Publication of the ordinance was authorized.

X-It was pointed out that there were many people residing outside the City Limits that were desirious of securing City Water and were willing to lay and construct water lines and sanitary sewer lines at their own expense and are willing to transfer title and control of such lines to the City. After some discussion it was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by D. M. Thrash, that a resolution be passed, authorizing the City Manager to execute contracts in behalf of the City of Lufkin, with such individuals, and persons living outside the City Limits, for such water and sewer lines. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

3 It was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan that a man be secured to complete plans for the New City Park. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.
