

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 6th day of June 1917 at 7.30 pm with the following named officers present, K. Morgan mayor presiding; S. W. Hawthorne, G. W. Largent, W. D. Price, J. A. Behannon and W. D. Newson Aldermen, R. P. Walker secretary and J. W. Dunn City Attorney

By request of the water Committee and the city council W. L. Jones was appointed as Water Commissioner of the City of Lufkin Texas by K. Morgan mayor said appointment being for one year dating from the date said

7 K. Morgan qualified as mayor of the city of Lubbock Texas and the said H. L. Jones is to be paid a salary of \$75.00 per month as water commissioner out of the water works operating fund.

Moved by S. W. Hawthorne and seconded by W. D. Newsom that a water works Incidental fund be created to pay off incidental claims and that \$100.00 per month be set aside in said fund, monthly. It is ordered by the Council that a Street labor fund be created and that \$100.00 per month be placed in said fund and it is ordered by the Council that a resolution or ordinance be drawn up and signed by the Mayor and City Secretary defining said funds and that said Resolution and ordinance become effective from its date. It is also ordered that a Fire Engine Fund be created.

It is ordered that the City Attorney draw up an ordinance to abolish an ordinance heretofore passed by the City Council known as a budget ordinance, There being no further business before the Council it was moved and seconded and so ordered that Council adjourn till Monday night June 11th 1917 at 7.30 p.m.
