The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of all meetings held during the month of August were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN OCCUPATION TAX ON THE OPERATION OF EVERY COIN OPERATED MACHINE OF WHATEVER KIND OR CHARACTER AND MARBLE TABLES AND MARBLE MACHINES, REQUIRING A LICENSE AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY" was presented for passage and approval on first reading. It was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by W. A. Abney that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it pass first reading. The motion was put by the mayor and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- W. A. Foster, W. O. Greene and W. A. Abney. "NOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed on first reading.

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All bills and accounts due by the city to various parties firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid on motion duly made and carried there were ordered paid.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
