An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN
PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN TO J. E. WILSON AT PRIVATE
SALE AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN
TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER TO J. E. WILSON A BILL OF SALE FOR SUCH PROP-
ERTY TO J. E. WILSON FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF \$450.00, CASH", was
introduced for passage and approval on second reading, after which it was
