

Lufkin Texas Oct. 10th 1917

The City Council of the city of Lufkin Texas met on the above date, Oct 10th 1917 in adjourned session with the following named officers present, K Morgan mayor presiding W. D. Price, S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Newsome and W. N. Cook aldermen, R. P. Walker Secretary J. S. Cochran marshal, A. O. Reed Deputy marshal and pound master, W. L. Jones water Commissioner and W. L. Sullivan Sanitary inspector when the following orders were made of record;

Ordered That K. Morgan mayor buy two spools of barbed wire and send them out to the New City Pond to repair the fence around said City Pond.

It is ordered That W. L. Jones water Commissioner place One Hundred (\$ 100.00) Dollars of the money he collects as water rent in the water works Incidental fund.

It is ordered That Sam H. Townsend City-attorney prepare and draw an Ordinance creating a permit fund

3 It is ordered That the mayor notify Sam Griffin to vacate the old house that he is now occupying at the New City Pond and that John Saxon and Tom Russell be allowed to use said old house to build stalls for their stock.

It is ordered That the Secretary buy a supply of metal dog tags to tag dogs with.

There being no further business The Council adjourned to meet in called session Oct. 15th 1917
