Motion by alderman Fairchild, second by alderman Taylor, all aldermen voting Aye that the Mayor, Secretary, and the City attorney arrange certain registered town warrants making the propers. change in the records so that the holders thereof could realize their money on same from out of the Street and alley trads of City of Lufkin.

Motion made by alderman Kerr, seconded by alderman Taylor, that an ordinance, " styled.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF PERMANENT STREET IMPROVEMENTSWITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND PROVID-ING RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH REFERENCE THERETO" be passed and admit adopted. The vote on this question stood as follows: "AYES" Kerr, Taylor, and Gibson. Noes, alderman Fairchild. Alderma Fairchild stating his reason for voting against said ordinance "AYES" Alderman being the reading of that portion of same, wherein it reads as folly ows: " The City Council shall have the right to accept any bid deemed most advantageous and beneficial to the City, and shall have the right to reject any and all bids"

The Mayor declared the ordinance passed and adopted.

Motion by alderman Fairchild, seconded by alderman Gibson, that an ordinance, styled, " AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DESIGN& ATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WITHIN AND FOR THE GITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF STREETS AND MAKING CERTAIN REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO THE PROPER ENFORCEMENT AND CONDUCT OF SAID IMPROVEMENT" be passed and adopted.

The vote on this question stood as follows: GAYES" aldermen Gibson, Taylor, Fairchild and Kerr. "NOES" None.
