

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD MARCH 2nd, 1920.

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of March, A.D. 1920, there was begun and holden a regular session of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof.

Roll being called the following officers of said City Commission answered present: G. A. Kelley, Mayor, E. E. Woods, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, C. B. Edwards, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, W. B. Treadwell, Commissioner of Ward No. 4; Commission S. R. Parker of Ward No. 1 being absent. City Manager, L. Mitchell, and City Secretary, T. L. Dunn, being also present.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

Minutes of former meetings of the City Commission were read, and by move and second duly made and carried, were approved and adopted.

Accounts and bills due by the city to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for allowance and payment, and after careful examination of same, and it further appearing that same had been audited by City Manager L. Mitchell, and ok'd by him, by move and second duly made and carried, all such accounts and bills were allowed and the City Secretary ordered to write city warrants in payment of same.


It appearing that the fiscal year in the business of the City closes with March 31st, 1920, and that the City Charter provides that an audit of the Books of the City shall be made each year, by move ~~and~~ by E. E. Woods and second by Edwards, which move and second duly carried by a unanimous vote of the City Commission, L. Mitchell was ordered and directed to secure the services of an auditor to audit the books of the City as aforesaid.

It appearing that it would be necessary to secure the services of some one to collect the street taxes for the year beginning February 1st, 1920 and ending February 1st, 1921, it was duly moved and seconded and duly carried that L. Mitchell, City Manager secure the services of some responsible party to collect said street taxes.

The report of J. T. Maroney, Judge of the Corporation Court of the City was presented, and after examination of same, it was moved and seconded to accept and approve said report. Said motion duly carried and said report is hereby approved.


After the discussion of other matters pertaining to the affairs of the city in a general way, and in which no action was taken, move and second was made to adjourn. Carried.
