

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS.
Jan. 20th. 1916.

Be it remembered that on this the 20th. day of January A.D. 1916 there came on and was held a called meeting of the City Council of the City of Lufkin, Texas at the Council Chamber of Said City in accordance with the adjournment of the regular meeting on Jan'y. 4th. 1916. Those present were as follows:

The following business was had to wit:-

After considerable discussion with reference to the method of payment of out-standing warrants and providing funds for the installation of a new pump at the City Reservoir No. 2, for laying additional water mains and other improvements, it was moved by Alderman Price, which motion was seconded by Alderman Davis that the Council adopt an ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4, OF ORDINANCE No. 101 entitled, 'AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY SECRETARY TO ENTER INTO A GENERAL CONTRACT WITH JOHN HABLIN FOR INSTALLING ENGINE AND PUMP AT CITY RESERVOIR, FOR LAYING WATER MAINS; FOR ENLARGING PUMP STATION AT SAID RESERVOIR; AND FOR STREET PAVING AND OTHER PURPOSES'", passed and approved on the 2nd. day of November A.D. 1915.", the same being ordinance No. 118 of the City of Lufkin, TEXAS.

On being put to a vote, all aldermen voted for and in favor of the passage and adoption of said ordinance No. 118.

After a general discussion of affairs and there being no further business to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Price and seconded by Alderman Hawthorne that the Council adjourn. All Aldermen voting "AYE"
