Number Two, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor, S. R. Parker, Jr.
2. The meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the special election to fill the vacancy from Ward No. 2, caused by the resignation of Commissioner Jack Nerren. The election judges made due returns of said special election to fill the vacancy from Ward No. 2, held April 23, 1957, and upon canvassing such election returns, the Commission finds there were 841 votes cast, of which Parker McVicker received 288 votes, W. C. Royle received 543 votes, and there were 10 mutilated ballots. W. C. Royle, having received a majority of 255 votes, was declared the duly elected Commissioner from Ward No. 2, to fill the unexpired term caused by the resignation of Jack Nerren.

Mr. Royle appeared before the Commission, after the canvassing of such election returns, and took the oath of office as Commissioner from Ward No. 2, City of Lufkin, Texas.

3. There being no further business to come before the Commission,  
the meeting adjourned.
