

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD ON MARCH 9th, 1948 A.D. 7:30 P.M.

On this the 9th day of March, A.D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a called meeting in the Regular Meeting Place in the said City with the following members, thereof, to-wit:

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The purpose of the meeting was to read and approve current bills due various parties and concerns, and to act on any other matter that might come before the council.

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Mr. A. J. Conn was present in regard to Zone Change that had been previously advertised for Public Hearing. Mr. C. C. Sinclair made motion that since no one had appeared to protest the Zone Change From Zone "F" to Zone "H" on Mr. Conn's property in Block 29 of the Denman Addn. to the City Of Lufkin, Fronting on South First St., next to the Cities Service Station, that same be approved as Zone "H". G. W. Roland seconded the motion. The Mayor put the matter to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

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Martin Dies, Jr., W. L. Slaughter and several property owners were present in regard to street Paving in the Parkview Addition. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash, that the City pay one-third (1/3) plus and additional one-sixteenth (1/16), since Mr. W. L. Slaughter had proposed to pay \$210.00, and Temple and Associates one-sixth (1/6) and the property owners paying their required 1/3 of the property along the creek which was said to be approximately four-hundred feet. The Mayor put the matter to a vote . All voted "AYE" . "Noes" None.

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Birch Street located between Scarbrough Street and Sayers Street came up for discussion, and a motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin that Birch Street be officially closed. Mayor put motion to a vote . All voted "AYE", "Noes" Nones.

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An amendment to our Awning Ordinance was read, and a motion was made by C. C. Sinclair and Seconded by D. M. Thrash, that same be adopted on First Reading. Mayor put motion to a vote . All voted "AYE". "Noes" None. (See another page in regard to Ordinance.

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A new ordinance in regard to Concrete Sidewalks and etc., was read and discussed, and L. C. Martin made motion that same be adopted on first and Second Reading. G. W.

Roland seconded the motion. All voted "AYE". C. C. Sinclair made motion to adopt . .
same on Second Reading, and seconded by G. W. "oland. All Voted "Aye" "Noes" None.

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There being no further business to come before the council, so meeting adjourned.
