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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LIMITING THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF DRIVE-IN FILLING STATIONS; DEFINING DRIVE-IN FILLING STATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OR REFUSAL OF PERMITS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY"

was introduced for passage and approval on secpnd and final reading: J. B Perry made a motion that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on second and final reading: W. D. Winston, Jr. seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. D. Winston, Jr. J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor dēclared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on sec-ong and final reading.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TAXICABS; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF CHAUFFEURS AND LEVYING A FEE THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF TAXICABS AND LEVYING A FEE THEREFOR; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING A SAVING @CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF POL-ICIES OF INSURANCE"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading: W. D. Winston made a motion that said ordinance be placēd on second and final reading and that be passed and approved on second and final reading. The motion was seconded by J. B. Perry. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W.D. Winston, Jr., J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NOES" None- Whereupon the Mayor dēclared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on sec-onh and final reading.

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An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR A. D. 1937"

was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading.

J. B. Perry made a motion that the ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it be passed and approved on second and final reading. J. E. Jay seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- Kenneth Hoskins, W. D. Winston, Jr., J. B. Perry and J. E. Jay. "NNOES"- None- Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
