

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in regular session on this the 4th day of March 1919 at 7.30 P.M. with the following named officers present;

Walker Secretary when the following orders were made by the Council. The report of J. E. Walker the Street Commissioner was accepted with some amendments to be made to said report said report being now on file with the City Secretary for a full investigation by the Street Committee to see that said amendments or correction have been made to make said report balance.

A motion by S. W. Hawthorne, one of the Aldermen to reimburse Dr. Linwood Derrman for over charges in tapes on Lot # 3 in Block # 44, ^{was lost} there being no second to said motion.

It was moved and seconded that the Secretary notify the City Marshal to see the party or parties who are building or have clausets built on or near the streets in the Milam addition removed at once.

Ordered that W. L. Jones, fire chief be and he is hereby authorized to buy a bedstead and some bedding for Tom Webster, one of the firemen. The being no further business the Council adjourned.
